






## Floor Plan Area Map

This is a recently refurbished house, which is now being let on a room by room basis, with a maximum of four tenants in the property.

The ease of a rental like this is huge, as all you will have to pay every month is just your rent. That's right, all your gas, electric, water, council tax, and wifi bills are included within the rent!

The room comes with a double bed, a double wardrobe, a chest of drawers, and one bed side table. You will have access to a communal kitchen, a communal sitting room, and one shared full bathroom, along with a separate shared WC.

The minimum term tenancy is six months, and then thereafter it can be agreed to go onto either a new fixed term, or a periodic monthly tenancy.

To secure this property, you will need to pay a holding deposit, equivalent to 1 week of rent, which on this room is £109.61. This holding deposit will secure the room for you whilst the referencing takes place, and then will count towards your security bond upon successful referencing.

As you move in, you'll be required to pay your first month of rent upfront (total of £475), along with the rest of your security bond. The security bond is a total of £475, so will require an additional £365.39 to add to the money taken at the start of the application. Your security bond will be securely held with a deposit protection scheme and will be returned to you upon vacating the property, provided you've left the room in the same condition you received it.
